



## Stewardship Crew Member Position Description

**Position Overview:** The stewardship crew member will help with a variety of outdoor restoration and stewardship projects on Capitol Land Trust (CLT) conservation properties.

**Responsible To:** AmeriCorps Restoration Coordinator

**Key Responsibilities:**

- In conjunction with staff and/or other volunteers at CLT, restore and maintain the natural environments of CLT's properties. This may include activities such as invasive species removal, trail clearing, debris removal, and planting.
- Punctual arrival to the worksite in appropriate working attire.
- Engage with volunteers at stewardship work parties.
- Help with set-up and clean-up at large restoration events.

**Initial Impact:** Have meaningful experiences giving back to nature and the community.

**Sustained Outcomes:**

- Gain new and improve on existing skills.
- Steward land to improve and protect ecological function.
- Build relationships with community members.

**Training Provided:** Training will be provided the day of at the work site, including safety procedures for tool use and restoration methods.

**Support:** Stewardship Crew Members work with the AmeriCorps Restoration Coordinator, who will direct stewardship project tasks.

**Commitment:** Assist the AmeriCorps Restoration Coordinator at regularly scheduled stewardship events. We typically have opportunities once a week that can be found on the website and email newsletter. We may also reach out to you for smaller asks that don't require a work party.

**Skills and Qualifications:**

- No experience necessary.
- Willingness to work outdoors in various types of weather.
- Ability to walk on uneven terrain and perform varying degrees of physical work.

**Benefits:**

- Learn new skills like plant identification and restoration techniques.
